Trail Blazing

A RECORD PERFORMANCE --- Bill Walton, MVP of the 1977 NBA Finals, grabbed 23 rebounds, 20 at the defensive end, swatted away eight Philadelphia shots and scored 20 points to lead Portland to a 109-107 win over the Sixers in the deciding game of the 1977 Championships on June 5, 1977. The blocked shots and defensive rebound stats still stand as NBA Finals records 27 years later.

Trail Blazing

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE --The Trail Blazers won all 10 of their home playoff games en route to the 1977 NBA Championship, a league playoff record that still stands. Since then, three other teams have matched that mark--Boston in 1986, the Lakers in 1987, and Chicago in 1996. The 1977 Blazers were 14-5 overall in the playoffs. In Memorial Coliseum they were 2-0 against Chicago, 3-0 against Denver, 2-0 vs. the Lakers and 3-0 in the NBA Finals series with Philadelphia.
